

**Material List for Pen and Ink**  
**Fridays, October 11 and 18, From 10-1 p.m.**

Pen and Ink has a unique language with expressive flowing lines and a range of tonal depth. Using a Crowquille pen, **Sarah Saltus** will teach you how to create textures and various ink techniques, like a cross hatch and stipple, to allow you to produce representational ink drawings.

Paper: Bristol Plate Finish Drawing Paper for Ink - 11 x 14" pad,  
Grafix Duralar Mattes 9 x 12" pad

Ink: Higgins Black Magic Ink - permanent/waterproof 1 oz. bottle  
Micron Black ink pen 0.25 mm point and 0.005 mm point  
Chamois cloth to wipe nib.

Pens and Pen Holders:

**EITHER:**

Speedball Number 20 General Purpose Pen Set - This set includes Speedball (Hunt) Crowquille pen nibs - #100, #102, #103, #104, #107, and #108 with pen holders.

**OR:** you may purchase separately:

2 Speedball Crowquille pen nibs = #102 and #104 with 2 Crowquille pen holders - #102 and #104 nibs
