Paint: *Winsor & Newton Artists' Water Colour*, 5 ml tubes -Winsor Yellow Deep -Winsor Lemon -Winsor Blue (Green Shade) -Cobalt Blue Deep **or** *M.Graham* Cobalt Blue (less granular) -Permanent Rose -Scarlet Lake

Brushes: *Robert Simmons* White Sable (sizes 2 and 6) **or** *Winsor & Newton* Sceptre Gold II (sizes 2 and 6) You may also wish to invest in a higher quality watercolor brush - I recommend Raphael Series 8408 Red Sable Fine Pointed Round, size 4 (available from <u>dickblick.com</u> or jerrysartarama.com.

Palette: 1 or more Porcelain Watercolor palette(s) (I use "7-well Flower Palettes")

Ceramic/Porcelain white plate for additional paint mixing surface (optional)

Rag for cleaning brushes (non-linty, old t-shirts work well)

Container for water - disposable 4-cup size is good.

Sketching pencils - 2B, B, 4B

Kneaded Eraser

Tracing paper

Sketch paper, size 9x12 or 11x14

Watercolor Paper - *Fabriano Artistico* 140 lb Hot Pressed*. One sheet approx size 11x14 *Teacher will have paper available for purchase in class
