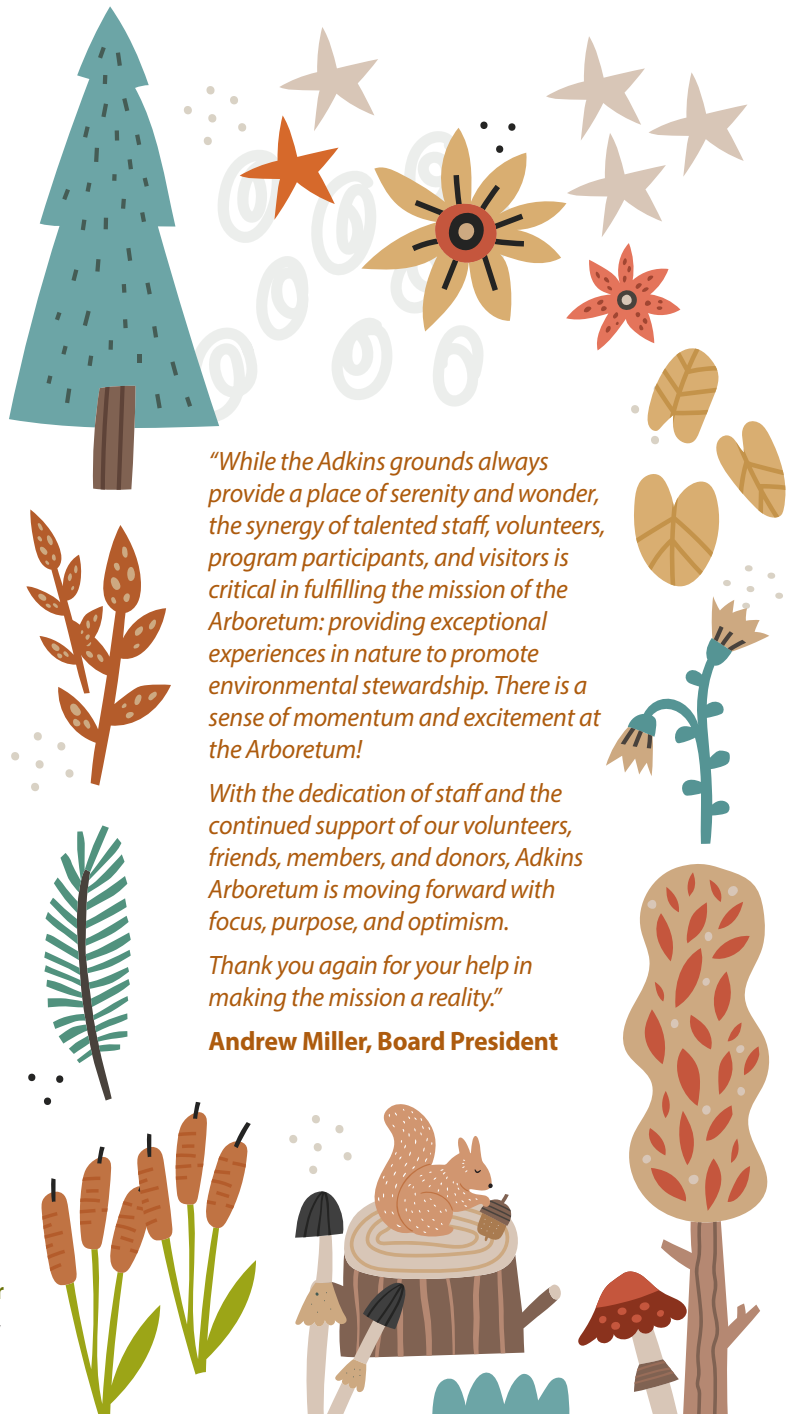

DEAR FRIENDS

You may recall that 2022 was a stop-and-go year. We scheduled our programs for a go year and succeeded with many aspects of that effort.

The virtual premiere of our Rooted Wisdom film was attended by more than 1,500 people. More than 2,600 students attended school field trips, upwards of 220 people attended each of our two Beer Gardens, and more than 400 participated in Fairyfest! Our plant sales, visitorship, membership, and praises remained high.

That said, and despite our best efforts after the pandemic, our income was down, expenses were up, and our small endowment took a hit, as did many in 2022.

But we are undeterred. The support of our members and donors and your kind words buoy each of us.

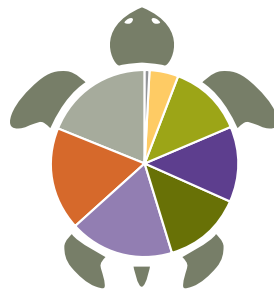

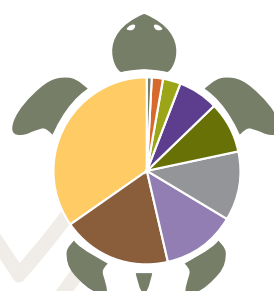
